HEAL PALESTINE

We have raised the necessary \$20,000 to bring a young person from Gaza to Fort Wayne for pro bono surgery.

We are working with Steve Sosebee, HEAL Palestine, to bring a youth from Gaza for surgery. In August, the US State Department suspended visas for people from Gaza to enter the country, even for humanitarian and medical reasons.

ICMEP had selected a 15-year-old male surgical patient who would have been part of the next group of Gazans to leave.
